LITANY OF CONFESSION

Leader: Gracious God, You called Abraham to trust Your promises and walk by faith into an unknown future. Yet we often cling to what is familiar rather than follow where You lead.

People: Lord, have mercy upon us and strengthen our faith.

Leader: You call us to be a blessing to others, yet we have too often lived only for ourselves and neglected those entrusted to our care.

People: Christ, have mercy upon us and enlarge our hearts.

Leader: On this Father's Day, we confess that we have not always modeled the faith, courage, compassion, and integrity You desire in us.

People: Forgive us, O God, and teach us to lead by faith and love.

Leader: We confess that we have doubted Your promises, trusted our own understanding, and failed to live fully into the grace and power You make available to us.

People: Renew our hope and help us trust You beyond what we can see.

Leader: You have called us into Your harvest and sent us to share Your love, yet we have often remained comfortable when You were calling us to serve.

People: Forgive us, Lord, and make us faithful laborers in Your Kingdom.

All: Merciful God, restore us by Your grace, strengthen us by Your Spirit, and shape us into people whose faith blesses future generations. Make us faithful fathers, mothers, mentors, disciples, and servants, that through our lives others may come to know Your love and trust Your promises. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
